AUTOMOTIVE COLLISION REPAIR TECHNOLOGY

- Safety glasses
- 2. Work shoes: Shoes or boots that will protect to or above the pant line, so that welding sparks or slag cannot funnel into the shoe. Hard soled leather or material that will not melt, and is not flammable. Hard toe is not required, but is acceptable.
- 3. Work clothes: Clothing that protects against dirt and welding slag. Clothes may not be frayed, and should be of a material that does not ignite easily (preferably cotton). Hats may be worn in shop to protect the head and scalp, but are for shop use only and should be old ones that will not be missed if lost or destroyed. Coveralls meet requirements and are suggested. Students should check with the instructor to determine shop coverall colors, if they are to be used.
